An Ever Vigilant Partnership

Vigilant Technology digital video recording systems have been given a major part to play at one of the most wide districts in Stevenage, UK

The Hertfordshire CCTV Partnership involves three local authorities, Stevenage Borough Council, North Hertfordshire District Council and East Hertfordshire District Council.

The Partnership's manager is Robert Holgate who combines a forward looking open minded approach to emerging technology with a desire to extract the highest evidential quality from recorded CCTV images. He talks here about the scope of the system and data gathering:

"We want our in house Police evidence Officer to be able to download evidence from remote locations either by IP, conventional or wireless links. He also needs to see images from our rapid response units that use mobile cameras in areas of high anti-social behaviour where there is no conventional CCTV coverage. We look to transmit these images back to the control room via the Orange network."

Areas covered by the scheme include the towns of Stevenage, Hitchin, Knebworth, Hertford, Letchworth, Royston, Baldock, Welwyn Garden City and from 2006 Bishops Stortford and Ware. One of the distinctive aspects of the scheme is the integration with the Broadband for Learning network across 452 primary and secondary schools in the area. The CCTV Partnership has a link with the main 10-meg school network to allow it to receive images of any incidents at its Stevenage control room. During the school day the schools monitor their CCTV locally but out of school hours and during holidays, the images are viewed at the control room.

Similar technology is also being used at leisure facilities and is about to be extended to Play Groups and Cemeteries.

Future expansion as well as existing requirements led Robert Holgate to believe that he would need a customised solution approach to the CCTV Partnerships digital recording requirements, which included a need for audio recording.

Evidential quality

The Hertfordshire CCTV Partnership looked at solutions offered by a number of manufacturers before opting for an Enterprise system from Vigilant Technology. Robert Holgate comments: "We visited a number of control rooms, one of them running Vigilant, and used them as reference sites. The functionality, simplicity and adaptability of the Enterprise system won the day.
